

Independent Study/Undergraduate Research Process Checklist

PROCESS FOR STUDENTS to register for Undergraduate Research, Independent Study, or Field Study credit

- 1 STUDENTS MUST ASK the faculty member if they can participate in the faculty member's research for Undergraduate Research, or if they will supervise the student's Independent Study.
 - > TEACHING ASSISTANTSHIPS and peer mentorships qualify for Independent study credit. Please check with the instructor about any required application forms. Instructors may or may not use applications.
- 2. IF THE FACULTY MEMBER AGREES, the student must work with them to complete the <u>Undergraduate Research/Independent Authorization</u> form.
 - THEY MUST BE SURE to complete all fields on pages 1-2, except the section labeled "For office use only."
 - LEAVE THE CRN BLANK unless the instructor already has a CRN assigned to that particular type of Undergraduate Research/Independent in the Timetable (i.e. UTAs for a specific course).
- 3. THE STUDENT SUBMITS the completed form to the <u>School of Animal Sciences Tiny</u> URL.
- THE SCHOOL OF ANIMAL SCIENCES Undergraduate Education Office will review the form and assign a CRN.
 - > FORMS THAT REQUIRE revision will be returned.
- ONCE APPROVED, the student will be added to the course, which will show up on their schedule.
 - UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH forms will be submitted to CALS (College of Agriculture and Life Sciences) by the Undergraduate Education Office. CALS will add the student to the course.
 - INDEPENDENT STUDY forms will be processed by the School of Animal Sciences Undergraduate Education Office. The Undergraduate Education Office will add the student to the course.

NOTE: Students may only earn 6 total credits of Undergraduate Research and 6 total credits of Independent Study for a TOTAL of 12 hours. These limits may apply to all Independent Study and Undergraduate Research courses across all departments. Students may not enroll in additional Independent Study/Undergraduate Research credits once these thresholds have been reached.
